Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

What We Do			
How does GLOBALING protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include encryption, computer security protocols and secured files and buildings. We also maintain other physical, electronic and procedural safeguards to protect this information and we limit access to information to those employees for whom access is appropriate.		
How does GLOBALING collect my personal information?	We collect your personal information, for example, when you Open an account Show your driver's license/identificatio Provide account information Give us your contact information Conduct transactions using the accou We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates or other companies		
Why can't I limit all sharing?	Federal law gives you the right to limit only: Sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes - information about your credit worthiness Affiliates from using your information to market to you Sharing for non-affiliates to market to you State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing. See below for more on your rights under state law.		
Definitions			
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies.		
Non-affiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies. GLOBALING does not share with non-affiliates so they can market to you.		
Joint Marketing	A formal agreement between non-affiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. GLOBALING does not share your personal information for joint marketing with non-affiliated companies.		

Other Important Information

For California Residents. We will not share information we collect about California residents with companies who are not affiliates, except as permitted by law, such as with your consent or to service your accounts. Among our affiliates, we will limit information sharing to the extent permitted by California law. You are not required to contact us for these elections to apply.

For Nevada Residents. We are providing you this notice under state law.
